



# NOTTINGHAM MALAYSIAN SOCIETY UNIVERSITY OF NOTTINGHAM



## GENERAL

1. The University of Nottingham and Nottingham Malaysian Society (NMS) will not be held responsible for any losses of valuables, injuries incurred or breakage of equipment during any event. Participants are advised to take appropriate measures to ensure the safety of their belongings.
2. By participating, individual/s and/or team/s agree to abide to all the rules and regulations set by Nottingham Malaysian Society.
3. Only members of their respective Malaysian Societies are allowed to take part in Nottingham Malaysian Games, and as such, shall register together as one contingent. Malaysian Societies are allowed to register non-Malaysians, so long as they are members of your Society, and their number does not exceed half of the total players in a team. We would expect, through mutual trust that necessary steps are taken by respective Malaysian Societies to ensure this is the case, though we would not hesitate to ask for proof of membership as we see appropriate. However any individual or personal team would be welcomed to join depending on the organiser's consent.
4. Participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations of the Sports Centre and the respected venues. The Games Officials have the right to dismiss individual/s or participating team/s in an event where the rules have been breached or as seen appropriate by the regulations. Unruly behaviours or any conspicuous assault at our Games Officials would not be tolerated.
5. All disputes are to be referred to the NMS Games Committee, which will have the final say. Please make sure any issues regarding the validity of players or other issues concerning any events are made before the start of the event. Individual/s or team/s, which did not fulfill any aspects of the rules of their respective events, would be disqualified.
6. Captains (for team events) must take the responsibility to ensure their team is ready and available for their event at least 5 minutes before it starts. Please notify any problems to the Official/s in charge of the particular event. Unless a reasonable excuse is brought forward or any given circumstances are justified, the 'Walkover Rule' will apply.
7. Nottingham Sports Centre and NMS will provide sporting equipments/ facilities for certain events which requires us to do so; i.e. shuttlecocks for badminton, table tennis balls etc. but it is

the responsibility of each participant to bring their the necessary equipment/s to compete in their respective events.

8. Registration fees would not be refunded once paid. No refunds will be given to team/s or participant/s that is/are disqualified or dismiss from their respective events unless for a justifiable reason.
9. NMS Games committee has the right to alter the rules any of the respective events to ensure it ends in time and according to schedule.
