TABLE TENNIS

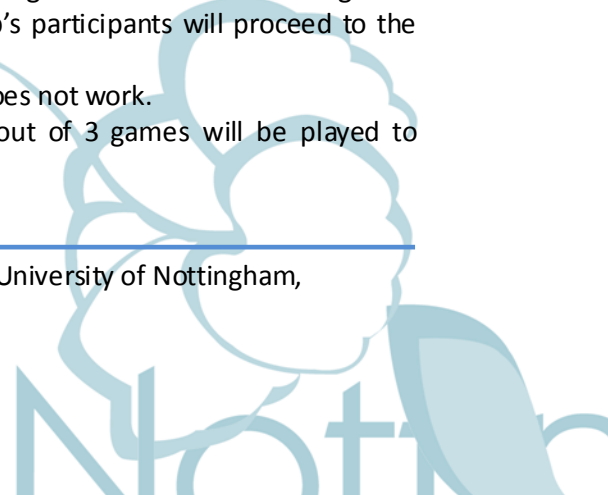
1. All games will be scored, refereed and decided on any dispute by the volunteer official.
2. Players are advised to be in court **10 minutes** before matches start. Players who do not turn up on their matches will be forfeited. If late, a 2-3 minutes waiting time may be posed depending on time situation. All decisions are to be finalized by Head Official.
3. The Quarter Master has the right to alter the rules to ensure it ends in time and according to schedule.
4. All decisions by volunteer officials and Quarter Master are final.
5. Please respect all decision made as it is crucial to the flow of the competition as well as the best the interest of others.

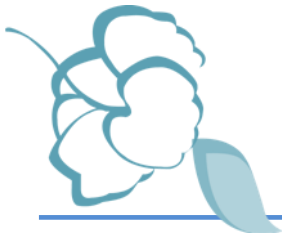
MEN'S SINGLE

1. Basic rules of table tennis apply.
2. Eight groups of round-robin-system will be played on first round. Round-robin-system is based on a single game of 11 points. First player to reach 11 points wins.
3. Marking system will be applied on first round, players will be given 1 POINT for winning each match. The players with the highest marks among his group's participants will proceed to the Quarter-finals.
4. Scores of the match will be compared if the marking system does not work.
5. Knockout system applies on Quarter-finals, semi-finals, & Finals. a best out of 3 games will be played to determine the winner.

WOMEN'S SINGLE

1. Basic rules of table tennis apply.
2. Four groups of round-robin system will be played on first round. Round-robin-system is based on a single game of 11 points. First player to reach 11 points wins.
3. Marking system will be applied on first round, players will be given 1 POINT for winning each match. The players with the highest marks among her group's participants will proceed to the Semi-finals.
4. Scores of the match will be compared if the marking system does not work.
5. Knockout system applies on semi-finals and finals, a best out of 3 games will be played to determine the winner.

MIXED-DOUBLES

1. Basic rules of table tennis apply.
2. Two groups of round-robin system will be played on first around. Round-robin-system is based on a single game of 11 points. First player to reach 11 points wins.
3. Marking system will be applied on first round, players will be given 1 POINT for winning each match. The players with the highest marks among the group's participants will proceed to the finals.
4. Scores of the match will be compared if the marking system does not work.
5. Knockout system applies on finals, a best out of 3 games will be played to determine the winner.
