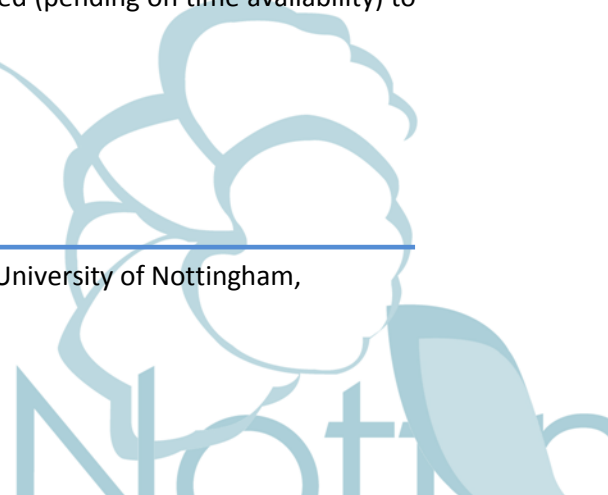


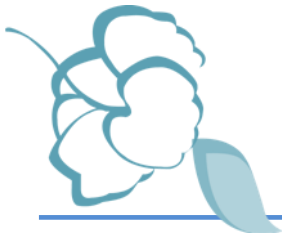
TENNIS

1. All games have to be scored and refereed by players themselves (provide a volunteer referee per university). The volunteer official will be stationed on each table to decide on any dispute.
2. There will be 4 courts. One court will be allocated for warm-up (optional and up to QM's decision). Warm-up court (if time permits) is open **ONLY** for players who are playing within the next 10 minutes. For example, if your game is at 10.00 am, you are allowed to use the warm-up table from 9.50-10.00. The other three courts are used for matches.
3. Players are advised to be in court **10 minutes** before matches start. Players who do not turn up on their matches will be forfeited. If late, a 2-3 minutes waiting time may be posed depending on time situation. All decisions are to be finalized by Quarter Master.
4. The Quarter Master has the right to alter the rules to ensure it ends in time and according to schedule.
5. The NMS committee will conduct the draw before the Games begin.
6. All decisions by volunteer officials and Quarter Master are final.
7. Please respect all decision made as it is crucial to the flow of the competition as well as the best the interest of others.

MEN'S SINGLE
